

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1 OF 2020

CITY OF MONONGAHELA, COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MONONGAHELA
DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

I, Gregory Garry, being the duly and lawfully elected Mayor of the City of Monongahela, Washington County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, pursuant to 11 Pa.C.S. § 11203(d), hereby declare a state of emergency commencing on April 1, 2020 generally throughout the City of Monongahela and in those manners more particularly set forth herein.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have declared a novel coronavirus (COVID-19) a “public health emergency of international concern,” and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Secretary has declared COVID-19 to be a public health emergency in the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2020, Hon. Tom Wolf, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, declared a statewide disaster emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Board of Commissioners of Washington County, Pennsylvania declared a county-wide emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 Pa.C.S. § 11203(d), the Mayor of a Third Class City has the powers to declare a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, due to the increase of cases and potential of exposure to the novel coronavirus in and around the County of Washington and the City of Monongahela, a state of emergency is existing and will continue to exist in the City of Monongahela.

DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in me as the Mayor of the City of Monongahela, I, Gregory Garry hereby DECLARE A STATE OF EMERGENCY TO EXIST CITYWIDE IN THE CITY OF MONONGAHELA, and further hereby ORDER, DECLARE, AND PROCLAIM as follows:

1. Order to Stay at Home: Pursuant to the Order of the Governor of March 27, 2020 concerning Washington County, all individuals are ordered to stay at home except as provided by the Governor’s orders in regard to life-sustaining activities and businesses.
2. Pursuant to Paragraph 1, all parks contained within the City of Monongahela, including the Aquatorium, are hereby closed until further notice.
