AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MONONGAHELA, COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 15, PART 5 – ON-STREET METERED PARKING §511(2) – TICKETING OF VEHICLES PARKED UNLAWFULLY, EFFECT OF PAYMENT WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS, §512(1) PENALTY FOR VIOLATION, PART 6 – OFF-STREET METERED PARKING §611(2) – TICKETING OF VEHICLES PARKED UNLAWFULLY EFFECT OF PAYMENT WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS, AND §612(1) PENALTY FOR VIOLATION TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

§511(2) AND §611(2)

2. The police officer or other person making the report shall also place on or attach to the vehicle a notice to the owner or driver of the vehicle that the vehicle was parked in violation of this Part, and instructing the owner or driver that if he will report to the office of the Chief of Police and pay, according to the following fines:

Parking Meter	\$ 4.00	Fire Hydrant	\$25.00
Double Parked	20.00	No Parking Zone	10.00
Blocking Alley	10.00	Improper Parking	10.00
Blocking Driveway	10.00	Yellow Line	15.00
Against Traffic	10.00	Official Signs	10.00
Handicapped Parking	25.00		


The Fine for Parking Meter Violation is \$4.00 if paid within the next 24 hours. If not paid within the next 24 hours the charge is \$10.00 and \$15.00 for Yellow Line, \$20.00 For Double Parked and \$25.00 for Handicapped and Fire Hydrant violations.

§512(1) AND §612(1)

1. Any person who violates any provision of this Part, with the exception of §509 and §609, and who fails to pay the fine set forth in §511 and §611 shall be cited within twenty (20) days of the violation and upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$20.00 plus court costs for all violations except Handicapped Parking and Fire Hydrant which the fines shall be \$25.00 plus court costs.


Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.
