**RESOLUTION NO. 16 OF 2019**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MONONGAHELA, COUNTY OF WASHINGTON,  
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE INTER-MUNICIPAL  
TRANSFER OF RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE R-11512 FROM THE CITY OF  
WASHINGTON TO THE CITY OF MONOGAHELA**

WHEREAS, Act 141 of 2000 (“the Act”) authorizes the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board to approve, in certain instances, the transfer of restaurant liquor licenses across municipal boundaries within the same county regardless of the quota limitations provided for in section 461 of the Liquor Code if, as in the City of Monongahela, sale of liquor and malt or brew beverages are legal in the municipality receiving the license; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires the applicant to obtain from the receiving the municipality a resolution approving the inter-municipal transfer of the liquor license prior to an applicant’s submission of an application to the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

WHEREAS, the Liquor Code mandates that, prior to adoption of a resolution by the receiving municipality, at least one hearing be held for the purpose of permitting individuals residing within the municipality to make comments and recommendations regarding applicant’s intent to transfer a liquor license into the receiving municipality; and

WHEREAS, an application for transfer filed under the act must contain a copy of the resolution adopted by the municipality approving the transfer of a liquor license into the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Hog Fathers Old Fashioned BBQ, LLC, has requested the approval of the City of Monongahela for the proposed transfer of Pennsylvania Restaurant Liquor License Number R-11512, from Hog Fathers Old Fashioned BBQ, LLC, 1301 Jefferson Avenue, Washington, PA, 15301, to Hog Fathers Old Fashioned BBQ, LLC, 243 East Main Street, Monongahela, PA, 15063, with the understanding that the transfer must be approved by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Monongahela has held a properly advertised public hearing pursuant to the notice provisions of Section 102 of the Liquor Code to receive comments on the proposed liquor license transfer; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Monongahela approves, by adoption of this resolution, the proposed inter-municipal transfer of Liquor License Number R-11512 into the City of Monongahela by Hog Fathers Old Fashioned BBQ, LLC; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Monongahela finds and determines that the approval of the inter-municipal transfer of Liquor License Number R-11512 will further the economic development within the municipality; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that transfers, designations and assignments of licenses hereunder are subject to the approval by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board.


